We use **strip compliance packaging**, meaning patients' medications are separated out and clearly labeled in individual plastic pouches by time and day in which they need to take their medications. This convenient way of tracking medication alleviates the worry of you and patients remembering if they took their medications and the extra time it takes to separate out meds by hand. These packages are also incredibly travel-friendly and cuts down on clutter—no sea of medication bottles in sight! Instead, our sleek boxes have a small footprint and collapse for easy recycling.



We also can **sync up your residents' medications to be delivered FOR FREE** at the same time every month, leaving the guesswork out of when medications are ready.

Medication verification is also very important to us, which is why **we'll contact you or your health team monthly before we start filling prescriptions** to make sure all medications are correct and up-to-date.
